Healing* evangelist.* The post-World War 2* healing revival* in Pentecostalism* began in the ministry* of William Branham, an independent so- called "Holy Ghost" Baptist* minister* from Jeffersonville, Indiana. In 1946 Branham claimed that an angel commissioned him to be a prophet with the message of divine healing. From 1946 to 1955 Branham conducted a healing ministry that only Oral Roberts* could match. The Pentecostal masses revered his legendary healing gifts, the ability to detect diseases by the vibration of his hand and the ability to discern the secrets of a person's heart.

As healing revivalism transformed into the broader charismatic movement,* the unsophisti- cated Branham did not readily adapt. Attempting to cope with declining popularity, Branham increas- ingly asserted doctrinal revelations regarding the end-time message of God. The most controversial revelation was his claim to be the end-time prophet to the Bride of Christ. Since his death in 1965, Branham's
